Fees are competitive and marketing materials will be provided. Master classes, workshops and/or lecture demonstrations can be arranged with any engagement, and fee reductions will apply to added classes or lectures.

**Performances** are available for evening or matinee engagements. Programs of four to six dance works last from one to one and a half hours.

Fee: \$1500–\$3000

**Master** classes taught by Artistic Director Cori Terry and company members will focus on the basic principles of normative technique and Wellspring’s evolution of it through current repertoire. Company members assist and demonstrate during this 1 1/2 hour session.

Fee: \$200

**Workshops** demonstrate the basics of movement and modern dance, and provide non-dancers with the experience of interacting with professional dance artists. A popular choice by schools and community groups, Wellspring develops unique workshops to share the joy of movement with special populations, such as developmentally disabled adults and inner-city youth.

Fee: \$350–\$500

**Lecture/Demonstrations** involve demonstrations by Wellspring company members as Terry describes the dancers’ regime, including technique class, the rehearsal process, and the creation of a dance. Excerpts from original choreography performed by the entire company proved a glimpse into Wellspring’s unique contribution to modern dance during this one hour program.

Artistic Director Cori Terry was born in Brooklyn, attended the State University of New York at Stony Brook and completed her dance training in New York City. She joined the Erick Hawkins Dance Company in 1974, performing and teaching in major cities throughout

the U.S. and Europe. In 1980 she moved to Kalamazoo as Artist-in-Residence at Western Michigan University, forming Wellspring in 1981. She has twice received a Michigan Council for the Arts and Cultural Affairs Creative Artist Grant for choreography and was the recipient of Kalamazoo's prestigious Community Medal of Arts in 1987.

Terry completed a BFA in dance at WMU and has since taught there as a guest instructor. She has led numerous master classes, including those at Interlochen Arts Academy, Grand Rapids Civic Ballet, Grand Valley State University and Northern Michigan University, and has choreographed more than 50 major works for Wellspring. She has been in practice as a certified Advanced Rolfer since 1996.
